We structure our offer around three stages of a student's journey through secondary school:

Engage and Inspire (Y7 – 8) Early engagement to spark curiosity and inspire.

Investigate and Explore (Y9 – 10) Deeper insight into pathways, skills, and opportunities.

Apply and Progress (Y11 - 13) Practical preparation for transitions and future success.
