- Level 3 Year 1 minimum of 36hrs actual external work experience. The main aim is external WEX, in some cases employer led live brief or VWEX can also be completed
- The remaining Level 1 and 2 employability hours totalling 26hrs should be made up of employer talks, employer events, employability modules, employer visits etc.
